

FAFSA Checklist: What You Will Need

- Your FSA ID** which you created on fsaid.ed.gov.
- Your Social Security number** and your parent's Social Security number if you are providing parental information.
- Your Alien Registration Number** if you are not a U.S. citizen
- Federal Tax Information or Tax Returns** including IRS W-2 information for yourself (and spouse, if you are married), and for your parents if you are providing parental information.
 - If you are filling out the 2019-2020 FAFSA, you will need 2017 tax information.
 - If you are filling out the 2020-2021 FAFSA, you will need 2018 tax information.
- Records of Untaxed Income**, such as child support received, interest income, and veterans' non-education benefits, for yourself (and spouse, if you are married), and for your parents if you are providing parental information.
- Information on your assets** including cash; savings and checking account balances; investments, including rental property; and business and farm assets for yourself (and spouse, if you are married), and for your parents if you are providing parental information.

UMB's Financial Aid Office encourages those students who are providing parental information to be accompanied by at least one parent when completing their FAFSA.
